NOTICE LOSS OF ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL STUDENT AID PROGRAMS FOR SENTENCES RELATED TO POSSESSION OR SALE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS

A conviction for the possession or sale of drugs can disqualify a student for Federal Student Aid (FSA) if the conviction occurred while the student was receiving federal financial aid. (Convictions for conspiring to sell drugs are also include) The chart below show the period of ineligibility for FSA funds, depending on whether the conviction was for sale or possession and whether the student had previous offenses.

| | Possession of Illegal Drugs | Sale of Illegal Drugs |

| 1 st offense | 1 yr from date of last Conviction | 2 yr from date of last Conviction |
| 2 nd offense | 2 yr from date of last Conviction | Indefinite period |
| 3+ offenses | Indefinite period | |
